If you are submitting a grant application or responding to a contract proposal to NIH that includes a clinical trial, or are involved with conducting, managing, or overseeing clinical trials, learn about NIH policies, and find resources to guide you in your work.

Each type of NIH grant program has its own set of eligibility requirements. Applicants can find eligibility information in Section III of each funding opportunity announcement (FOA). While the principal investigator conceives and writes the application, NIH recognizes the applicant institution as the grantee for most grant types.

The R01 is the NIH standard independent research project grant. An R01 is meant to give you four or five years of support to complete a project, publish, and reapply before the grant ends. NIH gives you a 200 character limit, but don't feel obliged to use all of that allotment. Instead, we advise you to keep the title as succinct as possible while including the important information to distinguish your project within the research area.

Scoring & Summary Statements / NIH: National Institute of ...

Proposals and the budgets for projects being submitted to the National Institutes of Health (NIH) should be developed by principal investigators (PIs) with the assistance of their department and/or Office of Pre-Award Services (OPAS). Proposals must be submitted to OPAS following the 5 day proposal submission procedure.

NIH Proposal Guide / Research Administration

The first change expands your options by no longer requiring black body text. NIH still recommends that you choose black or other high-contrast text colors since they print well and are legible to the largest audience. The second change shortens the list of NIH-recommended font faces to these four: Arial, Georgia, Helvetica, and Palatino Linotype.

Review Guidelines for Grant Applications It is important to keep in mind the five criteria that reviewers are asked to apply when assessing the majority of grant applications. As defined in Step 2 these are: significance, approach, innovation, investigator and environment. Other criteria may be considered for other grant mechanisms.

After you have decided the area of research to pursue, start thinking about your planned experiments by first drafting objectives, known in NIH lingo as Specific Aims. Be sure you can complete your Aims within the typical timeframe for your chosen Funding Opportunity Announcement (FOA). For an R01, that's typically four to five years.
