Most, but not all, were signed in Utrecht in the Netherlands in 1713. France and Austria ended hostilities with the Treaty of Rastatt in March 1714; the Treaty of Baden (September 1714) ended war between France and the Holy Roman Empire; Portugal and Spain concluded negotiations in Madrid in February 1715.

Last Habsburg king; prematurely senile and expected to die at any moment at the time of the peace at Ryswick, yet he lived on; his death led to a large political balance in Europe because of his will that decided who would sit on the throne of Spain; Caused the War of the Spanish Succession between Louis XIV and Leopold (Habsburg); left Spain to Louis' grandson.

The Treaty of Utrecht was a result of the longstanding French-British rivalry, and ended as a victory for Great Britain. However, like all peace treaties of that era, it provided only a temporary break from hostility, which was shattered when European powers ultimately clashed in the global Seven Years War.

Utrecht’s greatest claim to fame in the history of international law is the textual inclusion of the principle of the balance of power in the text of some peace treaties. Article 2 of the Hispano-British Peace of 13 July 1713 (28 CTS 295) literally stipulated that peace in Europe could only be sustained if the balance of power were preserved.
